**~ Prayer Directives from the Word of God ~**

*Ask and it will be given to you, seek & you will find; Knock & the door will be opened to you.  
 For everyone who ask receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who  
 knocks, the door will be opened. ... ><> **Matthew 7: 7-8***

**1. Pray for the Harvest**

**Mt. 9:38** - Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field

**Luke 10:2** – He told them, -the harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few...

Ask the Lord of the harvest, **therefore, to send out workers**

**2. Pray for National and local leaders of government**

**I Tim 2:1** – I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—  
 For kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.

**3. Pray for the church, that God will make it praise in the earth.**

**Isaiah 62:7** - and give him no rest till he establishes Jerusalem and make her the praise of the earth.

**4. Pray that God will open doors for ministry of the word**

**Col 4:3** - And pray for us to that God may open a door, for our message, so that we may proclaim ministry of Christ for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should.

**5. Pray for those who have mistreated you.**

**Luke 6:28** - bless those who curse you and pray for those who mistreat you.

**6. Pray that you enter not into temptation**

**Luke 22:40** - Pray that you will not enters temptation.

**7. Pray that you may do no evil**

**II Cor. 13:7** – Now we pray to God that you will not do anything wrong. Not that people will see that we have stood the test but that you will do what is right even though we may seem to have failed.

**8. Pray that your love may abound toward all people**

**Phil 1:9** – And this is my prayer that love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight.

**9. Pray that your whole spirit, mind, and body are preserved blameless unto the coming of the Lord.**

**I Thess. 5:23** – May God himself, the God of Peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole Spirit soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ?

**10. Pray for the fullness of the Holy Spirit. (more gifts, more power, more wisdom)**

**Luke 11:13** – if you then, though are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your father in heaven gives the Holy Spirit to those who ask him.

**11. Pray that you may be able to interpret what you pray in your prayer language.**

**I Cor. 14:13** – For this reason anyone that speaks in a tongue should pray that he may interpret what he says.



**12. Pray for the Peace of Jerusalem**

**Psalms 122:6** - Pray for the Peace of Jerusalem; May those who love you be secure.

**13. Pray that we may lead a quiet and peaceful life**

**I Tim. 2: 1-2** – I urge, then first that all requests, prayers, intercession, and thanksgiving be made for everyone – for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good and pleases God our Savior.

**14. Pray to have the desires and the dreams that God wants you to have.**

**Psalms 37:4** – Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart.
